TERRORISM UPDATE BRIEFING August 9, 2010 0900-1200 hrs ROCKLAND COUNTY FIRE TRAINING CENTER AUDITORIUM

It has been almost 9 years since the attacks on America changed our world. How has terrorism changed and what future trends and threats do we need to prepare for?

This professional development briefing will provide emergency responders with an update on the current state and ever changing threats we face from terrorism.

MAJOR JAMES "SCOTT" TAYLOR from the US Army will provide an overview of the current state of the terror threat and probable future trends.

SUPERVISORY SPECIAL AGENT MICHAEL DRISCOLL, NY FBI will discuss several recent terrorism cases including those which directly impacted NY and discuss the contrast to some of the terrorism threats prior to 9/11. These case histories will be very helpful to emergency responders so they will be better prepared to plan for and respond to the next terror attack.
