The Rockland County Department of Health is no longer scheduling flu vaccine clinics this season.

If you would like to get a flu vaccine, please call (845) 364-2534 for an appointment to come to the Department of Health to be vaccinated.

The flu vaccine is available free of charge to adults 60 years and older. Patients with Medicare and Medicaid must bring their cards. Individuals 9 through 59 years of age can receive the vaccine, but will be charged a \$25 fee. Bring proof of Rockland County residency such as a driver's license.
