

5-Year Line Graph by Municipality

Except for the Town of Ramapo, no other municipality had over 100 applications in 2008. In fact, the Village of Chestnut Ridge (4), the Town of Clarkstown (91) and the Town of Orangetown (75) had the fewest number of development applications reviewed in 2008 since 1998. Consistently the towns within Rockland County have had the highest number of submission of GML reviews, generally reflecting the larger land area. However, in 2008 the Village of Spring Valley had more review submissions than the Towns of Stony Point and Haverstraw. The Town of Orangetown had the highest number of submissions in 2002 and 2003 while the Town of Clarkstown had the highest number of submissions in 2004, 2005, 2006 and 2007. The Village of New Square submitted only 4 reviews to the County Planning Department between 1998-2007. The Village of Haverstraw has seen the largest increase in the number of reviews received from 0 in 2002 to 42 applications reviewed in 2006. The Town of Ramapo had the largest increase in the number of applications received in 2007, doubling the number from 71 in 2006 to 142 in 2007. This increase is again reflective of the number of variance applications received for review.
