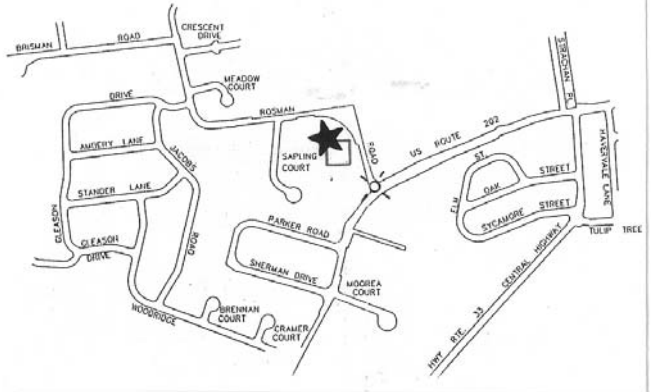
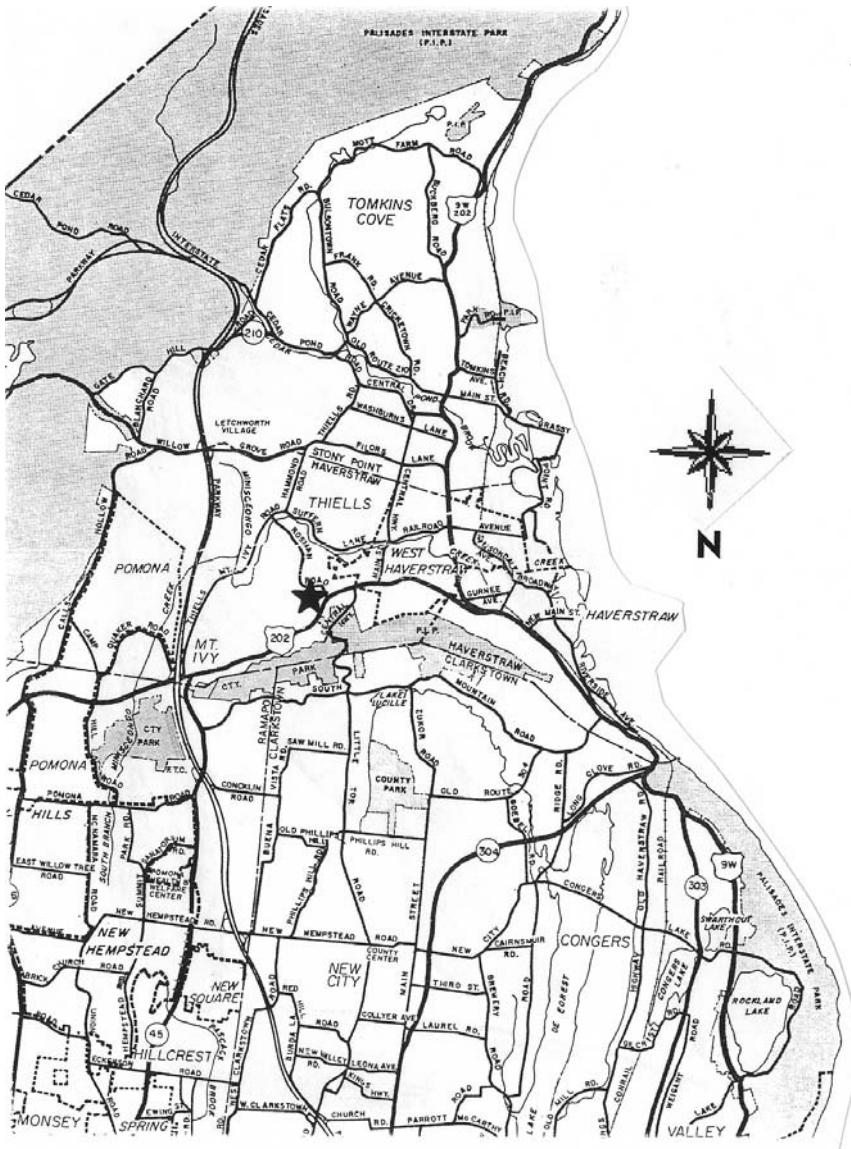

**DIRECTIONS TO TOWN OF
HAVERSTRAW TOWN HALL**

From the North:

Take 9W south to Route 202. Turn right onto Route 202. Continue for approximately 2 miles. Turn right at the traffic light at the intersection of Rosman Road and Route 202 (Bank of New York is on the far right corner). The Town Hall building is on the left just past the bank.

From the West:

Take Route 202 east to the intersection of Rosman Road. Turn left onto Rosman Road. The Town Hall building is on the left just past the bank.

From the South:

Take Route 45 north to Route 202. Turn right at the light onto Route 202 eastbound. Travel approximately 2 miles. At the intersection with Rosman Road, turn left (the Bank of New York is on the corner). The Town Hall building is on the left just past the bank.
